EXPANSION MSC HOME TERMINAL

MSC Home Terminal is proud to inform you that 'The City's Dock' has expanded with an extra quay-length of 440m, on the north side of the Delwaide Dock (quay 736). This quay used to be in concession with P&O (now known as Dubai Ports).

MSC Home Terminal is a 50/50 joint venture between MSC, the second largest shipping company in the world, and terminal operator PSA HNN (PSA's biggest investment outside of Singapore).

On the first of January, construction works on quay 736 began. In just a few months, the extra space has been turned into a state of the art part of the container terminal.

The first vessel, the MSC Tamara, berthed on the 8th of July at 13.00h.
